Term Dates

Return to school: Wednesday 4th January.

Parents will receive **class-specific letters** inviting their children to participate in the activities.

Applications open on Tuesday 10th January 2023 and must be completed before 12 noon on Friday 27th January 2023. You have until 12 noon on 31st January 2023 to upload a birth certificate and any other supporting documentation.

P7 Post Primary Transfer

Applications have to be **completed online** for those children moving into Post-Primary school in September 2023.

Admissions criteria will be published on Thursday 12th January 2023. Online applications will open at 12noon on Wednesday 1st February 2023 and will close at 4pm on Thursday 23rd February 2023.

Further details will be given to parents of the pupils in Primary 7.

Homework

Homework will resume on Monday 9th January for all classes.

It's important that we hold a current phone number for all parental contacts. If you have recently received a new phone number, please inform the school secretary as soon as possible.

Attendance

Please continue to provide a reason why your child is off using the absence form on the school app in the Parent area.

New guidance states that pupils should be off school for a minimum of 3 days after a positive Covid-19 test or symptoms but please ensure they are well enough to return to school.

If your child suffers from diarrhoea or vomiting, they should remain at home for 48 hours after their last bout of sickness.
